Thank you for your interest in the proposed low-level radioactive waste import. EnergySolutions applied for an NRC import license on Sept. 14, 2007 to import approximately 20,000 tons of radioactive waste from Italy for processing and disposal. The NRC evaluates all waste import licenses in accordance with the following criteria: "The proposed import will not be inimical to the common defense and security; the proposed import will not constitute an unreasonable risk to the public health and safety; and an appropriate facility has agreed to accept the waste for management or disposal." Also, as part of the review process, we work with the affected State(s), Low Level Waste Compact(s) (if applicable), the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (if necessary), and the U.S. Department of State. We also take into consideration comments received on the license application from interested members of the public. Your email will become part of the public record for this import application review. Again, thank you for your interest in this matter.
