Enclosed is a copy of the proposed Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) license conditions requiring fingerprinting, which will implement Rats ID 2007-4. One of the conditions is for new licensees and the other is for existing licensees. The changes indicated in red text are the DSHS changes from the sample license conditions contained in FSME-08-005. DSHS intends to begin adding the licensee conditions to the approximately 230 licenses already required to implement the increased controls requirements in early February. Therefore, we request NRC's comments by February 7 at the latest. Our intent is to add the license conditions to the licenses prior to a planned DSHS fingerprinting workshop on March 6, 2008 in Austin.

We believe that these license conditions satisfy the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Programs (FSME) Procedure SA-200.
