Hi Guys ! I spoke to the Bwd thermal performance engineer re: the AMAG calcs. Each feedwater loop has an AMAG instrument installed upstream of the venturis. In the calculation, they assign a separate AMAG constant for each loop. Basically, when calculating the calometric, the computer will look at the respective points for feedwater info and then used the assigned AMAG constant for each loop for calculating power. This is supposedly the same approach that Byron is using.

Pete/RIck since this appears to be different from what you understood, you may want to confirm with your thermal performance engineer if Byron is doing the same thing.
