Potesta & Associates, Inc. (POTESTA) has prepared this letter as a response and follow-up to your recent site safety inspection of POTESTA's offices in Charleston and Morgantown, West Virginia. As you will recall, POTESTA received a notice of violation related to training deficiencies related to 49 CFR 172.700. Mr. Ronald Ray Workman, at the time of your inspection, was conducting soil density testing for a construction project located near the town of Bradshaw, West Virginia. POTESTA's training records indicated that Mr. Workman's training certificate had expired on August 19, 2006.

As a result of this inspection, POTESTA immediately arranged for refresher training with the West Virginia Contractor's Association. Mr. Workman attended this one day training session on January 7, 2008. 


