Dear Mr. Kingsley:

The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has issued Facility Operating License No. NPF-90 (Enclosure 1), with the Technical Specifications (Appendix A), and the Environmental Protection Plan (Appendix B), for Watts Bar Nuclear Plant, Unit 1.

The technical basis for the license is included in the "Safety Evaluation Report Related to the Operation of Watts Bar Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2" (NUREG-0847), and Supplements 1 through 20. Supplement 20 (Enclosure 2) provides a concluding statement that Unit 1 is ready for a full-power operating license.

Enclosure 3 is a copy of a related <u>Federal Register</u> notice, the original of which has been sent to the Office of the Federal Register for publication.
