PURPOSE: In this session, the NRC staff will present its plan for the implementation of Inspection Procedure (IP) 71-003, "Post-Approval Site Inspection For License Renewal." The session will provide information to external license renewal stakeholders in a timely fashion in order to facilitate a smooth transition into the extended period of operation. This will include the NRC's expectations, inspection plans, and resource impacts on both the NRC and the licensees with plants with renewed operating licenses. The session will facilitate a common understanding of the staff's plan for verification of license conditions, licensee commitments and revised license commitments, FSAR descriptions, and newly-identified SSCs [§ 54.37(b)].
