The notification shall be made within thirty (30) days after full compliance has been achieved. This notification shall include a certification that the Trustworthiness and Reliability (T&R) Official, (and any subsequent T&R Official,) is themselves deemed trustworthy and reliable by the Licensee as required in B.2. of the Order. The licensees shall notify the Agency Texas Department of Public Safety, Intelligence Center at (866) 786-5972 within 24 hours if the results from a criminal history records check indicate that an individual is identified on the FBI's Terrorist Screening Data Base.
