Unit #1

Units #2, 3, 4, 5

- The ventilation duct is bended at the connection to the main stack. Investigation continues.
- Water which is thought to be from the spent fuel storage pool spread on the operation floor.

Unit #6

- Water which is thought to be from the spent fuel storage pool spread on the operation floor.
- Water with radioactive material was found at 3 and 3M floors on July 16.

Unit #7

- Water which is thought to be from the spent fuel storage pool spread on the operation floor.
