Mr. Setchel stated that, as of this date, the E-vial had not been recovered. I asked Mr. Setchel to determine the following: The manufacturer of the sealed source, its model and serial numbers, and the activity of the sealed source. Mr. Setchel stated that he would get back in touch with me with the information if it was available.

01/09/2008 08:30 Mr. Setchel left the requested information on my voice-mail. The Barium-133 vial was manufactured by International Isotopes Idaho, Inc., it was a model BM06-33, and it had serial number BM0633006-34. The sealed source had an initial activity of 281 microcuries.
