All,

Paul Krohn had me dig up some information concerning the time line for Meeting Notices for Public meetings.

Regional Instruction 0570.4 "Meetings with External Stakeholders" states: "Generally, announcements should be made no fewer than 10 calendar days before the meeting. When a meeting must be scheduled, but cannot be announced 10 calendar days in advance, as much advance notice as possible should be provided."

NUREG/BR -0224 "Guidelines for Conducting Public Meetings" gives guidance that public meetings will be scheduled normally 2 wks in advance, but no less than 1 wk.
