This letter is in response to: (1) your e-mail to Kevin Ramsey, dated January 1, 2008, requesting hard copies of all Biannual Effluent Monitoring Reports from Nuclear Fuel Services, Inc. (NFS) from 2000 to the present; (2) your letter to Fuel Facility Inspection Branch I, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Region II, dated January 10, 2008, requesting hard copies of all inspection reports regarding NFS issued since 2003, and all inspection reports issued in the future; and (3) your letter to the Technical Support Branch, NRC Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards, dated January 10, 2008, requesting hard copies of all inspection reports regarding NFS issued since 2003, and all inspection reports issued in the future.

We appreciate your interest in these matters and your participation in public meetings last September. During those public meetings, we discussed concerns regarding documents withheld from the public under the Official Use Only (OUO) Policy. This policy was in effect from 2004 to 2007. The Commission has directed the staff to redact and release certain documents from that period. This effort is ongoing, with a completion date of May 2008. Many of the documents you requested are available to the public already in the Agencywide Document Access and Management System (ADAMS).

A list of the ADAMS accession numbers for these documents is attached. Hard copies can be obtained through the NRC Public Document Room (PDR) for a fee. The PDR can be contacted by e-mail at hdr@nrc.gov, by phone at 800-397-4209, and by mail at U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Public Document Room, Mailstop O1F13, Washington, DC 20555. Information is available on the Internet at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/pdr.html>. ADAMS accession numbers for more documents will become available in the coming months. The PDR staff can help you search for additional documents.

With regard to documents issued before 2004, you must request those documents under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). FOIA requests may be submitted by e-mail to FOIA@nrc.gov, by facsimile to 301-415-5130, or by mail to the FOIA Officer, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC, 20555. Information is available on the Internet at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/foia/foia-privacy.html>.

With regard to future inspection reports, we will add your e-mail address to the distribution list for these reports. This is our standard distribution method, and it will result in a message stating that an inspection report has been issued and providing the ADAMS accession number for retrieving the document.
