

Radiation Protection Program Template Guidelines

- Current commission policy clearly states that operational programs should be described at a functional level and at an increased level of detail where implementation choices could materially and negatively affect the program effectiveness and acceptability.
- Each template should have an introduction that describes how this template is to be used to both issue a COL and to support completion of the program prior to fuel load.
- The purpose of these templates are not to provide actual operating program procedures, but to establish generic and consistent content for the FSAR, that is necessary and sufficient to make a reasonable assurance finding, and that demonstrates how the applicant will develop and implement the program.
- All templates will describe and require a consistent level of system design and operating information from all applicants, regardless of whether they are co-located or "greenfield".
- All templates should have the following general types of information
 - Generic information that all applicants should refer to by reference
 - Site specific information that is to be supplied by the licensee when the program is complete, prior to fuel load.
