SUBJECT: REQUEST TO AMEND RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE NO. 37-07161-01

Please remove Dr. James Tegeler as an authorized user on our radioactive materials license. Dr. Tegeler resigned from his position as radiation oncologist at York Hospital.

Please add Reena K. Pramanik to our radioactive materials license for the radioactive material included in 35.300 for therapeutic use of radioactive material for which a written directive is required.

- Dr. Pramanik's documentation for training and experience, including supervised clinical cases were provided in our license renewal application dated July 31, 2007.
- Written documentation from the Radiation Safety Officer from University of Iowa that all of Dr. Pramanik's preceptors were authorized users of radioactive material on the University of Iowa broad-scope radioactive materials license was provided to you in a letter dated December 17, 2007.
- Attached is an attestation from our medical director of Radiation Therapy that Dr. Pramanik "has achieved a level of competency sufficient to function independently as an authorized user for the medical uses authorized under 35.300." From your letter of January 11, 2008, our original request to add Dr. Pramanik for 35.300 was denied because this specific language was missing from Dr. Pramanik's documentation.

Please expedite this request. Dr. Pramanik's expertise is urgently needed for our clinical workload.

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
To Whom It May Concern:

In our license renewal, we applied for authorized user status for our radiation oncologist, Reena Pramanik, for radioactive materials included in 10 CFR 35.300 to include I-131 and beta- and gamma-emitting radiopharmaceuticals.

At the time of our license renewal, we provided portions of NRC Form 313 to document Dr. Pramanik's didactic education, written attestations from her preceptor at University of Iowa that Dr. Pramanik had satisfactorily completed the requirements in paragraphs (a)(1) and (b)(1)(ii)(G) of 10 CFR 35.300 regarding her supervised work experience with I-131 and Y-90, and written letters from the University of Iowa Radiation Safety Officer that all of Dr. Pramanik's preceptors were authorized users on the University of Iowa broad-scope radioactive materials license. The documentation of supervised work experience under Dr. Malik Juweid was obtained by Dr. Pramanik at the time of her radiation oncology residency, and was not on the NRC Form 313.

Dr. Pramanik has now been working in our Cancer Center for 1 year. She is a valuable and esteemed colleague, and we need her expertise in the clinical care and treatment of our patients. I have worked beside her and collaborated with her on many patient cases and can confidently attest that **Dr. Reena Pramanik "has achieved a level of competency sufficient to function independently as an authorized user for the medical uses authorized under § 35.300."**

I further attest that I meet the requirements as an authorized user in that I am an authorized user of the radioactive materials included in 10 CFR 35.300 on NRC License No. 37-07161-01, and have experience administering dosages for all of the material included in 10 CFR 35.300.
