SNC's response to NRC RIS 2008-01 for proposed VEGP Units 3 and 4 is as follows:

To ensure that the NRC will have adequate time to effectively schedule resources and to
facilitate the staff's ability to achieve an acceptance review of 60 calendar days, the staff
requests that, 90 days prior to the expected submission date, applicants declare their expected
submission date (month, day, year) to the NRC for each ESP, LWA, DC, and partial or complete
COL application.

Response: Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC) currently intends to file the VEGP 3 and 4 Combined License Application on March 31, 2008. SNC continues to be in discussion with the Westinghouse/Shaw Consortium on contract issues whose outcome may effect this submittal date.

2) In addition, the staff is seeking future notification regarding ESP, LWA, DC, and partial/complete COL applications expected to be submitted in FY 2010 no later than 30 days from the date of this RIS. This information will assist the staff in determining fiscal year 2010 budget needs.

Response: At this time Southern Nuclear Operating Company does not have any plans for submittals in the 2010 timeframe. However, there is a possibility that SNC could submit either an ESP or COLA for a site other than the proposed VEGP site in late FY 2010. SNC will notify the NRC if any plans develop during this timeframe.
