INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

ACCEPTANCE: This is to advise you that those individuals in Enclosure 1 have been accepted for participation in the training course (G-304) "Inspecting for Performance - Materials Version." This course is scheduled to be presented April 1-3, 2008, at the NRC Technical Training Center, 5746 Marlin Road, Suite 200, Osborne Office Center, Near Eastgate Shopping Center, Chattanooga, Tennessee 37411-5677, Telephone (423) 855-6500.

COURSE: This course will be conducted beginning at 8:00 a.m. and end at 4:00 p.m. each day except for Thursday, April 3, 2008, when the class is scheduled to end at 12:00 noon. Cellular phones and similar devices with audible capability should be disabled while classes are in session. Normal office/business attire is appropriate for students attending training. Please complete the invitational travel authorization request as described in FSME Procedure AD-500, "Invitational Travel Authorization and Voucher" and return it to Traci Kime at TSK@nrc.gov or fax it to 301-415-3502. If you have any questions regarding the travel form please contact Traci on 301-415-8140. No rental cars will be authorized for travel. You will need to take a taxi or shuttle to and from the airport. You will receive a travel voucher for reimbursement after the course ends. Traci will mail it to your office.

LODGING AND TRAVEL: You should plan to arrive on Monday, March 31, 2008, and depart on Thursday, April 3, 2008. Participants must make their own lodging and travel arrangements. Individuals should request a Federal government employee rate at the hotels.
