Subject: Order Suspending License For Non-Payment of Fees.

Summary: RI received notification from HQ that an Order had been sent to the licensee and requested that we contact the licensee. I spoke with Dr. Weiss and he related the following: Due to floor loading problems, the licensee was not able to purchase the imaging camera and other equipment to begin their nuclear medicine program. The suite is built over the parking lot and cannot sustain the weight of the imaging camera. The State of New Jersey was informed and they cancelled the license issued to the licensee and did not pursue the collection of fees. Dr. Weiss also stated that the New Jersey representative stated that they would contact the NRC about the cancellation of the New Jersey license. I examined ADAMS and stated that there was no indication that the State of New Jersey had contacted the NRC. Dr. Weiss stated that he had received the September invoice and February Order but not the October notification. Dr. Weiss also stated that he had spoken to Shirley Crutchfield of the NRC about the issue and that he had sent her a letter in October 2007. He was under the impression that he would not owe any fees or that the fees would be reduced. Since he did not receive further communication from the NRC, he believed that he did not owe any fees. I told him that I would inform our fees people about his problem but that he should contact them directly to see if the matter could not be resolved. If he should pay the fees and maintain the license, then he would be billed again for a similar amount of money in September of every year. If the decision is to terminate the license, then he should draft a letter stating that they have never possessed licensed material and wish to have the license terminated. Dr. Weiss stated that he would contact our people in fees and would seriously consider terminating the license.
