SUBJECT: PROPOSED RULE – FEE RECOVERY – FISCAL YEAR 2008

A copy of the *Federal Register* notice of proposed rulemaking, "Revision of Fee Schedules; Fee Recovery for Fiscal Year (FY) 2008" is enclosed. The notice describes the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's proposed amendments to the licensing, inspection and annual fees charged to its applicants and licensees.

It is requested that the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs notify the Agreement States to make distribution of this proposed rule to their licensees. The rule would modify the Part 170 fees currently assessed to those Agreement State licensees who perform work in non-Agreement States under the reciprocity provisions of §150.20. The reciprocity fee will decrease from \$1,500 to \$1,400 under the FY 2008 proposed rule.
