
Dr. Lackey has received certification by the American Osteopathic Board of Radiology in Diagnostic Radiology.

Dear Ms. Smith:

I am writing in response to your letter, dated July 26, 2005, seeking recognition of the American Osteopathic Board of Radiology (AOBR) certification processes for Diagnostic Radiology and Radiation Oncology by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and subsequent letters dated October 19, 2005, January 25, 2006 and April 27, 2006 and e-mail dated June 23, 2006, providing supplemental information.

NRC staff reviewed AOBR's certification process for the Diagnostic Radiology and the Radiation Oncology specialties and determined, based on the above cited letters and supplemental web site communications, that the Diagnostic Radiology specialty meets the applicable requirements in 10 CFR 35.290 and 35.392 and the Radiation Oncology specialty meets the applicable requirements in 10 CFR 35.390, 35.490 and 35.690 for NRC recognition. Accordingly, AOBR's certification process for Diagnostic Radiology and Radiation Oncology will be listed on NRC's web site for Part 35 matters at <http://www.nrc.gov/materials/miau/med-use-toolkit.html> with recognition dates of July 1, 2000, and May 1, 2007, respectively.

Please notify the NRC, via letter, six months in advance of AOBR plans for becoming inactive or disbanding, as well as of changes to certification procedures that would affect the recognition of AOBR's certification processes under the requirements of 10 CFR 35.290, 35.392, 35.390, 35.490 or 35.690.




