
- 8.) As previously stated the president of the corporation has changed, the radiation safety officer will remain the same, and no other changes are proposed that would require a license amendment.

- 10.) All records have been maintained and have been transferred to the new licensee.
- 11.) Leak tests conducted to date indicate that no leaks are present in any of the licensed material and no contamination should therefore be present at the facility.

- 13.) The transferee agrees to abide by all commitments and representations previously made to NRC by the Transferor as described in the existing license issued to Pennsylvania Soil and Rock, Inc.
