Dear Ms. Ullrich,

This letter is pertaining to BioRelix, Inc. NRC license 06-31263-01. We are asking for the acceptance of the modification to the training responsibilities of the BioRelix, Inc. Radiation Safety Officer (RSO). We stated in our license that the RSO will be responsible for a Radiation Safety Training of all BioRelix, Inc. employees. We would like to change this statement to "RSO will be responsible for training or will reserve the rights to designate the trainer after appropriate evaluation of the trainer". The trainer should have:

- a minimum a college degree at the bachelor level in physical, chemical, biological sciences or engineering
- an experience in:
 - managing the shipping/receiving RAM
 - managing waste disposal program
 - monitoring, security and surveys of areas where RAM is used
 - emergency response
 - conducting audits and maintaining records
 - training in radiation safety
