Comment to the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission

Say NO to License Applications Nos. IW023 and XW013 (Federal Register Volume 73, Number 28, 2/11/08)

Dear Sir or Madame,

It is my understanding that EnergySolutions is applying for a federal license to import 20,000 tons, one million cubic feet and over 600,000,000,000,000 becquerels of radioactive waste mainly from Italian nuclear power and related industries into the US for processing including incineration, "recycling" (into unspecified waste streams and destinations), transport, and disposal.

I want you to know that I strongly oppose any license applications to import massive amounts of nuclear power waste from Europe. There is no reason for this toxic waste to be reprocessed, burned, melted, transported, and dumped in the United States. You must NOT bring more of this hazardous material into this country. We have no safe means of dealing with the waste from nuclear power plants that is already here, let alone more of it. It is an outrage that your agency is even considering approving these license applications, and I would appreciate a reply stating that you will unequivocally oppose these license applications.

I have apprised my representative and senators of this matter and asked them to do whatever they can to oppose your approval of these license applications.

Please put the safety and health of Americans before the profits and interests of nuclear corporations. It is your duty to do so.
