SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF YOUR NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE

By letter dated March 4, 2008, you informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive materials license. The NRC Form 314 dated March 4, 2008, stated that the authorized nuclear density gauge was stolen from the construction site at Pearl Harbor Naval Station, Ford Island, Hawaii on June 26, 2007. This event was reported to the NRC Operations Center and assigned number 43446 and NMED number 070388. The Naval Criminal Investigation Service (NCIS) assigned case number 02JU07-HIHN-019-6NNA to the event and performed the investigation. Special Agent Mark Politi was assigned to the case. Based on my conversation with Special Agent Politi on March 10, 2008, he stated that the case had been closed and the nuclear density gauge had not been retrieved.

The supporting documentation to the NRC Form 314 provided a copy of the last leak test result. The leak test result documents that there was no evidence of leakage of radioactive material from the sealed source while in your possession. The NRC staff has reviewed the supporting documentation to your NRC Form 314. Based on the documentation submitted and a review of your historical file, the staff concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the facility and the facility at 735 Bishop Street, Suite 230, Honolulu, HI 96813, is suitable for unrestricted use in accordance with 10 CFR 20.1402, "Radiological Criteria for Unrestricted Use." Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required.

Please find enclosed Amendment No. 04 to License No. 53-27792-01, authorizing your license termination. An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(20)(ii).

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's document system (ADAMS). 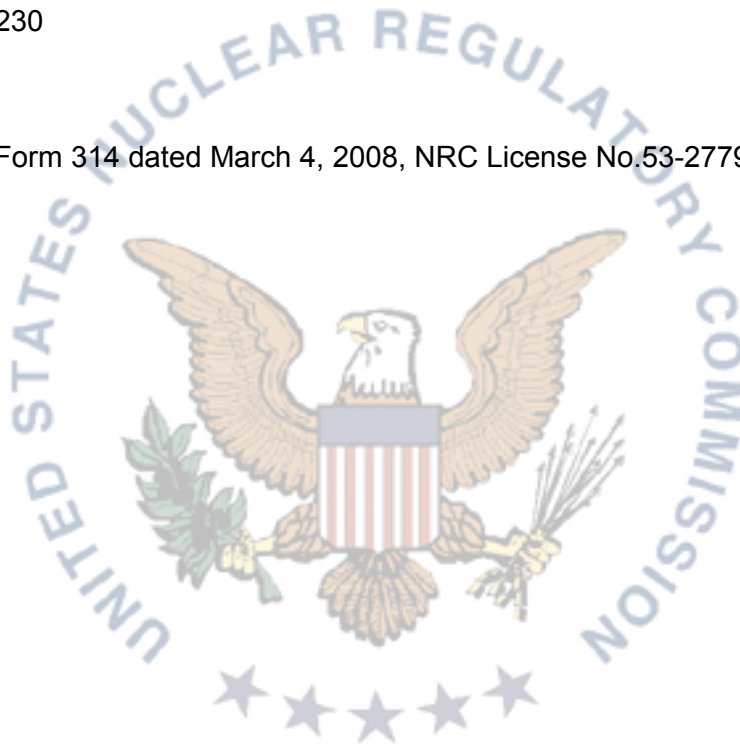
