This letter is to notify you that the Indiana Institute of Cardiology has dissolved as a corporation as of February 17, 2008 and wishes to transfer the nuclear license to the Indiana Heart and Vascular Institute.

The Indiana Institute of Cardiology was incorporated as a C corporation with the IRS. The Indiana Heart and Vascular Institute was incorporated as an S corporation with the IRS. This change in name and in corporate status was to prohibit double taxation.

There is no change in personnel or duties that relate to the program. There will be no training for new personnel. There is no change in the organization, location, facility, equipment or procedures that relate to this program. The only real change is the name and tax ID number.

You, Sue Weiss, have been appointed Radiation Safety Officer and are responsible for ensuring the safe use of radiation. You are responsible for managing the radiation protection program; identifying radiation protection problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; stopping unsafe activities; and ensuring compliance with regulations. You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of byproduct material by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations where justified by radiation safety. You are required to notify management if staff do not cooperate and do not address radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise issues with the State of Ohio at any time.
