10 CFR 50.59 Report of Changes, Tests, and Experiments for the Reporting Interval
of January 1, 2006, through December 31, 2007

Dear Commissioners and Staff:

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.59(d)(2), Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) is required to submit a report, as applicable, containing a brief description of any changes, tests, and experiments made to Humboldt Bay Power Plant (HBPP) Unit 3, pursuant to 10 CFR 50.59. A report of the 10 CFR 50.59 evaluations is required to be submitted at intervals not to exceed 24 months. Evaluations performed in accordance with 10 CFR 50.59 are performed as part of PG&E's licensing basis impact evaluation (LBIE) process.

For the reporting interval of January 1, 2006, through December 31, 2007, none of the changes, tests, or experiments evaluated under the 10 CFR 50.59 process reached the threshold of reportability for HBPP Unit 3. As a result, no changes, tests, or experiments for the reporting interval need to be reported to the NRC. The Plant Staff Review Committee has reviewed LBIEs during the reporting interval, and has concurred that the changes do not require reporting to the NRC.
