Dear Rulemaking & Adjudication Staff:

I am writing to you today to strongly oppose the licensing request by Energy Solutions, Inc. to import radioactive waste from Italy. This move will set a dangerous precedent of disposing European waste in the United States. I am worried that Utah will become the world's radioactive waste dump.

Approximately 1,600 tons of radioactive material would be buried in Tooele County. Tooele County is about 50 miles from Salt Lake County, which is a major metropolitan area.
