

Dear Secretary:

I *strongly* object to the disposal of Italian or other foreign nuclear waste in Utah's Tooele County. Utah residents should not be expected to bear the burden and accept the risks of living with radioactive garbage produced outside the United States. Italy benefited from its production of nuclear power and has the obligation to dispose of the waste within its borders. The people of Utah did not benefit from Italy's nuclear power and only a corporation, EnergySolutions, will profit from accepting Italy's radioactive trash.

Moreover, the transportation of nuclear waste across the ocean and around the United States to various states for processing increases the risk of a terrible accident or terrorist attack.
