

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing to express my strong recommendation that you reject the import license for EnergySolutions that would allow them to accept radioactive waste from Italy.

I have to agree with the Utah Radiation Control Board which stated in their request that you reject the license: "We believe that any country that has the technological capability of producing nuclear power within its borders should not seek to dispose of that waste outside them. Development of nuclear power should go hand in hand with the development of disposal options."

As it stands now, the Clive facility will accept waste products from the United States. While I wish there were better solutions for dealing with nuclear waste, it does make sense that we dispose of waste created here within our own borders. This facility has a limited capacity and should be meted out to companies that reside within the United States. Please don't force us to become the "easy way out" for companies and countries that are too cheap to deal with the proper and ethical disposal of the by-products of their energy production.

Please reject the import license for EnergySolutions!
