NUCLEAR METALS PENDING ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

On April 5, 1974, I called the President of Nuclear Metals, Mr. W. Tuffin. This call was made to fulfill a commitment that I would return his call - a commitment that was reiterated by Mr. H. Smith, his lawyer, when I talked to him on the afternoon of April 4.

The conversation was quite short in that I stated that I was just returning his call and told him that I was, as previously stated, going to review the matter very carefully; however, I indicated that I did not have enough time to complete my review and since I knew that he was going to California next week, I requested another date when we could get together. The agreed upon date was April 16 since he indicated April 15 was a holiday. Accordingly, I will return his call and by that time I would expect our position to be perfectly clear in that we will review all matters brought up by Mr. Tuffin and that these matters, once reviewed by me, will be discussed with Licensing in the technical area and with HQ to be sure that our position is clear. I would like all people involved in this problem case to conduct a careful internal appraisal of their actions to assure that Nuclear Metals gets a fair not a "soft" re-review.
