A complete, compiled electronic copy is also provided on the enclosed CD's for your convenience.




The DNSC respectfully requests an expedited review of the submitted documentation and, specifically, approval of the preliminary DCGL's and Final status survey Plan for the following reasons: All radioactive material has been removed from the depot. The DLA/DNSC is vitally interested in turning the Depot over to the General Services Administration (GSA) to sell the property. The only commodities present at the depot are some ores that are presently being sold and mercury which is being relocated; these commodities did not impact the MARSSIM process. The purpose of a submission of the DCGL technical basis at this time is to ensure coordinated communications between the DNSC and the NRC occur timely with meeting the DLA/DNSC strategic plans.
