- 1) This piece has not been relocated. Very heavy. Pat says it is about 2' across.
- 2) and 3) These are typical subsurface locations. There are a few more about the same or lower activity.
- 4) This area is East of the Greenville Metals Melt Shop. They do not do anything in this particular area. The outside areas west of here are not routinely occupied. (See attached figure)
- 5) I would guess that they have 20 to 30 employees. Less than half of these would work in the Melt Shop.

Thank you for the info. I have a couple questions, and we also have one request:

Questions:

- 1) The slag piece pictured as survey ID #1. Has it been relocated to the Whittaker site property?
- 2) The other survey locations (2 - 6) look to be subsurface. Is this correct?
- 3) Are these locations the only ones found so far (die to not yet having the Access Auth), and/or are they the hottest (I assume location 1 is the highest, but were the other spots everything else they found so far?)
- 4) You described to me yesterday what this portion of the Greenville property is used for, but I did not make note. Can you briefly tell me what they use it for (i.e. laydown, cooling of hot metal, general walkway, next to certain building, etc)
- 5) Do you know roughly how many employees work at Greenville metals? (on the order of tens or hundreds?)

Request:

Our Division Director has requested that Whittaker sends in a letter detailing the response to this event within the next week. Specifically, it should state that Whittaker has obtained from Greenville the letter we discussed yesterday (stating that Greenville employees will perform no unauthorized removal of the activities and that their current site fence provides access control). You also should request that Greenville provide (or that you provide for them) some information to its workers regarding the presence of this material and that it should not be disturbed. The letter should also state that Whittaker will perform additional characterization of the Greenville Metals property (To the extent you feel appropriate, although you should describe that extent to some degree. . . you may state that it will be fully described in the DP).

If you have any questions on the questions or on this letter, give me a call. I am also in tomorrow.
