As requested by Thomas E. Welch and in accordance with his letter dated May 13, 2005, and as requested by Roger Moroney and in accordance with his letters dated May 23, 2005, with attachments, and July 7, 2005, with attachments, your Tennessee Radioactive Material License number R-47174-L10 is amended as follows:

To change Conditions 13 and 25. These conditions will now read as follows:

13. A. Radioactive material authorized by this license may be used and/or prepared by, or under the supervision of, individuals who:
- a. Qualify as authorized nuclear pharmacists, as defined in SRPAR 1200-2-4-.04(1)(e), or
 - b. Meet the requirements specified in 1200-2-10-.35(1)(a)2. and the licensee has received an approved license amendment identifying this individual as an authorized nuclear pharmacist, or
 - c. Are designated by the licensee as authorized nuclear pharmacists and who have been identified as of February 4, 2002, as "authorized users" on a nuclear pharmacy license issued by the Division.

The licensee shall provide to the Division a copy of each individual's certification by the Board of Pharmaceutical Specialties, the Division, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, or other Agreement State license, and a copy of the state pharmacy license or registration, no later than 30 days after the date that the licensee allows, pursuant to 1200-2-10-.13(10)(a)4.(b)2.(i) and (iii), the individual to work as an authorized nuclear pharmacist.
