Please note that Dr. Kuehn was not added to your NRC License at this time. The preceptor form 313A(AUD) shows that Dr. Kuehn received his training required by 10 CFR 35.200 between July 1995 and June 1999. This exceeds the recentness of training requirement in 10 CFR 35.59. Further, on form 313A(AUT), there are two doctors listed that are receiving attestation. Please correct and resubmit all the required information for Dr. Kuehn in a new amendment request.


You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
