Dear Dr. Muller Runkel:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 69 to your NRC Material License No. 13-02047-02 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please note that Dr. Dehnee's authorization in Condition No. 12 does not reflect the restrictions you requested for generators and cardiovascular clinical procedures. This is because your license authorizes generators; Dr. Dehnee received training in generator usage; and NRC no longer excludes generators from the authorization for physician users qualified for the 10 CFR 35.200 modality.

Dr. Dehnee's restriction to cardiovascular clinical procedures is expressed on the license by my inclusion of your letter dated December 18, 2007, in Condition No. 15, the "tie-down" Condition.

Please also note that I corrected the authorizations for Drs. Prock and Kalokhe in Condition No. 12 to reflect the past deletion from your license of strontium-90 for intravascular brachytherapy.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
