South Carolina Electric & Gas Company (SCE&G) submits the enclosed Security Plan for the proposed V. C. Summer Nuclear Station (VCSNS) Units 2 and 3 as required by 10 CFR 73.20 and in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 52.79(a)(35) and 10 CFR 52.79(a)(36). This Security Plan is submitted as Part 8 of the Combined License Application (COLA) contained in Reference A above. The enclosed Security Plan contains safeguards information, and is to be protected from unauthorized disclosure as prescribed in 10 CFR 73.21.

The enclosed Security Plan is consistent with Reference B above. Appendix D, "Security and Contingency Plans for Independent Spent Fuel Storage Facilities," of Reference B is not applicable because no independent spent fuel storage facilities are being developed for VCSNS Units 2 and 3 at this time. Appendix E, "Additional Security Measures for Operating Reactors during Construction of New Reactor Plants within the Owner Controlled Area," is not submitted at this time as it has not yet been incorporated into Reference B. SCE&G will submit an Appendix E to the Security Plan within 6 months of NEI issuance of an NRC endorsed revised Reference B which incorporates Appendix E.

Note: The enclosed Security Plan contains Safeguards Information and must be protected accordingly. Upon separation from the enclosure, this letter is decontrolled.

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The NRC recently published a revision to 10 CFR 26, "Fitness for Duty Programs." In Part 7 of the COLA referenced above, SCE&G has requested a schedule exemption from the requirements of 10 CFR 52.79(a)(44) to include a description of the fitness-for-duty (FFD) program as part of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), which is Part 2 of the COLA. NEI is currently seeking NRC endorsement of an Appendix F, "Security Measures During New Reactor Construction," which will be incorporated into Reference B, to generically address the FFD requirements of the revised 10 CFR Part 26. Subsequent to NEI issuance of a revised Reference B which incorporates an NRC-endorsed Appendix F, SCE&G will submit, within 6 months, a corresponding Appendix F to the VCSNS Units 2 and 3 Security Plan to provide the FFD program.

In the enclosed Security Plan, changes to the approved text of Reference B above have been limited to administrative changes necessary to conform the generic document to a VCSNS site-specific plan.
