Hostile Action Scenario Task Force Recommendations

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Radiological Emergency Preparedness Program (REPP) staff will be briefing on the Hostile Action-Based Exercises and varying range of release scenarios and the proposed revisions to the guidance document, "Interim REP Program Manual" at the National Radiological Emergency Preparedness (NREP) Conference on April 7, 2008, in Las Vegas, NV.

In order to solicit input on the proposed revisions, FEMA REPP would like to engage the stakeholders at various meetings nationwide between May and July 2008. We would like to conduct several multi-state focus groups where general briefings are presented, but mainly FEMA's goal is to engage the State, local, tribal and industry stakeholders in an open two-way dialogue.
