APPLICATION – ENTERGY FOR THE GRAND GULF SITE**


Dear Mr. McMurtray:

Please find enclosed FEMA's response to your request for an Acceptance Review of the Entergy COL application, Grand Gulf site. The Radiological Emergency Preparedness (REP) Program staff from our Regional Offices (IV & VI) have reviewed the information pertaining to offsite emergency preparedness and response plans provided in the COL application and have found that in order to effectively support the start of Phase 1 of the offsite technical review, there is important information missing or needs further clarification as indicated in the enclosed document.

In addition, we have reviewed the draft schedule showing the time required (duration) for each task of the Grand Gulf Safety Review and concur with the schedule as written. However, it is important to note that the scheduled duration for the specific FEMA tasks not be reduced. It is understood that we may continue to make future requests for additional information in order to adequately support our effort in the technical review process.
