
Dear Mr. Thompson,


I am sending this letter to confirm that Victorinox Swiss Army (formerly Swiss Army Brands, Inc.) will no longer distribute any items manufactured with tritium including watches, alarm clocks and other timepieces from our new facility located in Monroe, Connecticut.

Victorinox Swiss Army will continue its watch repair operations in the new Monroe, Connecticut facility similar to the operations at its former Shelton, Connecticut facility. However, no new tritium containing product will be introduced.

Victorinox Swiss Army will continue its employee training, monitoring, survey, cleaning and management programs for all activities related to the tritium painted items similar to those established by our Radiation Safety Plan for the former Shelton facility to assure employee safety.



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
