Enclosed is Amendment No. 78, amending your NRC Material License No. 21-04125-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.


This letter also constitutes the requested "prior written consent of the Commission" of the planned transaction involving a "change of control" of the parent entities controlling Hackley Hospital, as described in the letter dated March 14, 2008, sent to us by facsimile on that same date, signed by Matthew R. Keuten of the Law Firm of Honigman Miller Schwartz and Cohn LLP. We understand that this transaction is scheduled to take place on April 1, 2008. Shortly after the transaction has been completed, the licensee will need to request a license amendment via a letter (which will be added to the tied-down condition of the license) signed by a high level management representative of the licensee, describing the change of control involving Hackley Hospital and the parent entities. Please include a diagram showing the relationships of the entities. This amendment request should also readdress the commitments confirmed in the second paragraph of the law firm's letter dated March 14, 2008, referenced above.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.
