Schedule for Providing Information Requested During March 18, 2008, Duke/NRC Meeting Associated With the License Amendment Request for Reactor Protective System/Engineered Safeguards Protective System Digital Upgrade (Technical Specification Change Number 2007-09)

Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (Duke) met with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on March 18, 2008, to discuss the License Amendment Request (LAR) submitted on January 31, 2008, associated with the Reactor Protective System and Engineered Safeguards Protective System digital upgrade. During this meeting, the NRC identified five issues in which they need further information to resolve. NRC requested Duke to provide a schedule for submitting this information by April 1, 2008. Subsequently, Duke requested and the NRC agreed that the submittal date could be extended to April 4, 2008.

Duke will submit the information requested by no later than May 29, 2008. Duke plans to provide information on each issue on the following schedule:

Additional Duke/NRC interactions are needed prior to providing these responses to make sure the issues are well understood and that the additional information provided satisfies NRC

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
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needs. Duke plans to further discuss these issues during weekly Duke/NRC teleconferences and a technical meeting tentatively scheduled for April 29, 2008.
