Dear Mr. Hamilton:

On March 14, 2008, the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a security baseline inspection at your William B. McGuire Nuclear Station, Units 1 and 2. Portions of the inspection were conducted at the corporate office from January 7 through 10, 2008. The inspection covered one or more of the key attributes of the security cornerstone of the NRC's Reactor Oversight Process. The enclosed report documents the inspection results, which were discussed with Mr. K. Ashe, Regulatory Compliance Manager, and other members of your staff on March 14, 2008.

This inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to security and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspectors reviewed selected procedures and records, observed activities, and interviewed personnel.

No findings of significance were identified.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system, ADAMS.
