The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Amendment No. 318 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-77 and Amendment No. 310 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-79 for the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2, respectively, dated April 2, 2008 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession ML080800504). These amendments were in response to your application dated April 5, 2007. They revised the surveillance frequency for the turbine trip functions of the reactor trip system instrumentation.
