Description:

In 2007, the staff held public meetings on July 19, July 24, and August 8, to explain its expectations with respect to the PRA information used to support the review of DC and COL applications. Discussions among prospective DC applicants, prospective COL applicants, and the staff indicated that additional clarification is needed to explain staff's expectations consistent with the requirements of 10 CFR Part 52.

The purpose of this interim staff guidance (ISG) is to provide additional guidance to the staff during its review of PRA-related information contained in DC and COL applications. This ISG also clarifies the staff's expectations pertaining to DC applicants, COL applicants, and COL holders concerning the format and content of the applications. This would supplement the guidance provided in Section 19.0, "Probabilistic Risk Assessment and Severe Accident Evaluation for New Reactors," of NUREG-0800, "Standard Review Plan for the Review of Safety Analysis Reports for Nuclear Power Plants" and RG 1.206, "Combined License Applications for Nuclear Power Plants."
