The purpose of this letter is to act as the updated STATEMENT OF INTENT for NRC License Number 01-07317-01. The transmission of this letter in conjunction with an updated CERTIFICATION OF FINANCIAL ASSURANCE should complete the financial assurance documentation update for the United States Environmental Protection Agency's National Air and Radiation Environmental Laboratory (NAREL), Montgomery, AL.

**STATEMENT OF INTENT**

As the Director of the United States Environmental Protection Agency's (US EPA), Office of Radiation and Indoor Air (ORIA), I oversee the National Air and Radiation Environmental Laboratory in Montgomery, AL. I exercise express authority and responsibility to request from the US EPA Administrator, funds for decommissioning activities associated with the operations authorized by the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Materials License Number 01-07317-01. This authority is established by the procedures outlined in the US EPA Resources Management Directives/Administrative Control of Appropriated Funds. A US EPA organizational chart and the ORIA organizational chart show how lines of authority are carried out. Within this authority, I intend to request that funds be made available when necessary in the amount of \$1,125,000 to decommission the following locations:

NRC license number: 01-07317-01, addresses of the facility's licensed locations per condition 10:

- A. 540 South Morris Avenue, Montgomery, AL
- B. Licensed material specified in Sub-Item 6.A-G. may also be used at temporary job sites of the licensee anywhere in the United States.

**NONNEGOTIABLE**

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I intend to request and obtain these funds sufficiently in advance of decommissioning to prevent delay of required activities.







I certify that the United States Environmental Protection Agency, National Air and Radiation Environmental Laboratory, Montgomery, AL, is licensed to possess the following types of sealed sources or plated foils with a half-life greater than 120 days licensed under 10 CFR Part 30:

Cobalt-60 Sealed Sources	20 millicuries per source
Nickel-63 Foils and Plated Sources	Not to exceed the maximum activity specified in the certificate of registration

In addition to the possession limits specified above, the licensee shall further restrict the possession of unsealed byproduct material to quantities less than $10^5$ of the applicable limits in Appendix B of 10 CFR Part 30, as specified in 10 CFR 30.35(d)



Additionally, unsealed special nuclear material licensed under 10 CFR Part 70:

Type of Material	Amount of Materials
Any byproduct material with Atomic Nos. 1 through 96 inclusive, except as specified below	10 microcuries per radionuclide and 100 microcuries total

I also certify that I anticipate that this Agency will be able to obtain appropriations of financial resources in the amount of \$1,125,000 for the purpose of decommissioning as prescribed by 10 CFR Part 30. This amount cannot be prior allocated or set in reserve due to anti-deficiency restrictions on expenditures by Federal Entities.
