To Whom It Concerns:

In response to the Notice of Violation sent March 12, 2008, Bryn Mawr College offers the following reply:

The Notice stated the College violated 10 CFR 20.110(c), which requires us to periodically (at least annually) review the radiation protection program content and implementation. The College regrets this omission, and attributes the situation in part to the transition to a new RSO (radiation safety officer) after the retirement of our former RSO and to a reduction in the scope and frequency of our isotope use.

The College engaged the services of a consulting health physicist, Robert D. Forrest, CHP, who performed an on-site review and program audit on April 1, 2008. We are awaiting his report at this time and plan to continue to engage him to provide ongoing technical support for our program.

To help ensure that an annual program review continues to be performed, an entry has been made in our Facilities Services work order system to automatically transmit a written request for a radiation protection program review to our RSO every year on March 1. The requirement has also been entered on a perpetual electronic calendar used for tracking environmental program requirements.

We believe we will have achieved full compliance with this violation upon receipt of the consulting health physicist's report, which is expected to arrive by April 18, 2008. We will implement any recommendations contained in the report at that time.
