SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF INVESTIGATION (OI 4-2007-047)

Dear Mr. Minahan:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC Office of Investigations (OI) regarding activities at the Cooper Nuclear Station. OI initiated the investigation to determine whether licensee personnel willfully violated procedures by conducting preventative maintenance under a RED risk configuration and whether licensee personnel willfully violated procedures by conducting corrective maintenance under a preventative maintenance work order.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, these concerns were not substantiated. The NRC plans no further action and considers this investigation closed.
