Dear Mr. Secretary:

I would like to comment on the proposal by Energy Solutions to import 20,000 tons of nuclear waste from Italy for processing in Tennessee and storage in Utah. The Import License Application number is IW023.

I TOTALLY OPPOSE THIS LUNACY WHICH IS DIRVEN ONLY BY THE GREED OF ENERGY SOLUTIONS. What kind of solution is it when you bring waste a third of the way around the world to dump it in the United States?

As you well know TVA stopped construction on plants at Yellow Creek, Tennessee and Hartsville, Tennessee in large part due to issues dealing with waste disposal. More recently, Hank Thompson (the County Executive for Sumner County), and a few of his cronies tried to push a waste processing facility down everyone's throat at the dormant Hartsville site. They didn't even have the manhood to hold public hearings. Again there was a resounding NO from the people of Tennessee.

If you include the Paducah Kentucky facility just north of the Tennessee line, Tennessee is already impacted by three nuclear processing facilities. The others are at Erwin and Oak Ridge.
