To Whom It May Concern:

This is a response to the NRC letter of violation of March 17, 2008, Docket No. 0303437
for License No. 29-31231-01.

Violation A:

Reason for violation:

Failure to follow existing Policies and Procedures

Specifically, failure to adequately document authorized user review and approval of
doses administered outside of the prescribed dosage range for ungated stress procedures.

Corrective Action:

Appropriate personnel including authorized users were provided written re-enforcement
of the need to adhere to prescribed dosage range as exists in the current procedure manual
and as posted in the laboratory. Deviations from the prescribed dosage may be approved
by the authorized users in consultation with the Radiation Safety Officer and written
change of the dosage must be documented in the patient log book, procedure manual, and
by E-mail to all appropriate parties. Above mentioned personnel must sign
documentation attesting to the fact that they received and understood the appropriate
policy and procedure.

Full Compliance:

Upon receipt of written attestations, no later than 30 days from the date of violation.

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Violation B:

Reason for Violation:

Failure to adequately document training and in-service education

Prior to commissioning the Bordentown facility, the technologist was brought into DEBORAH® Heart and Lung Center for instruction and in-service education on equipment, procedures, and radiation safety. However, formal documentation was not maintained.

Corrective Action:


All appropriate in-service education and instruction will occur prior to assuming duties and they will be documented in writing and maintained.

Full Compliance:

No later than 30 days from the date of violation.
