Dear Mr. Bobek:

On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I acknowledge receipt of your letter dated April 1, 2008 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML081050027). In your letter, the University of Massachusetts - Lowell (the University) submits that it has met its commitments formalized in NRC Confirmatory Action Letter (CAL) No. NRR-03-009, issued on October 22, 2003 (ADAMS Accession No. ML032720645). Specifically, the University has incorporated the site-specific compensatory measures into its NRC-required security plan. Thank you for informing us of this action, which may be examined during a future NRC inspection of your facility. Based on your letter and our previous inspection of your implementation of the compensatory measures, the NRC has found that no further response is required regarding the CAL, and the CAL is closed.
