RESOLUTION  
SUPPORT OF BELLEFONTE  
AS A NUCLEAR PLANT SITE

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) has submitted an application for combined licenses (COLs) to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to build units 3 and 4 at its Bellefonte Nuclear Plant site, and

WHEREAS, NuStart, a consortium of nuclear utilities that includes TVA, selected the Bellefonte site to build a twin Westinghouse-designed reactor-plant, and

WHEREAS, Highlands Medical Center operates four ambulance stations in Jackson County

WHEREAS, Highlands Medical Center has a 24-hour Emergency Department with a physician present around the clock

WHEREAS, Highlands Medical Center has more than 40 physicians who will be contacted in case of a disaster in Jackson County


WHEREAS, Highlands Medical Center has a close working relationship with Air Evac Air Ambulance, located on the Highlands campus

WHEREAS, Highlands Medical Center has an excellent, long-standing working relationship with the Jackson County Emergency Management Agency

WHEREAS, Highlands Medical Center has an external disaster plan and holds regular drills to implement the plan

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that Highlands Medical Center fully supports TVA in the completion of Bellefonte as a Nuclear Plant.
