Subject: **Decommissioning Funding Plan Revision 2**

Reference: Letter, J. F. Conant (ABB) to L. Kauffman (NRC), dated January 29, 2008

Dear Ms. Kauffman:

ABB submitted a Decommissioning Plan to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for remaining buildings and areas on the Combustion Engineering (CE) Windsor Site, with the exception of the Site brook and debris piles close to the brook (Reference). The letter committed that ABB Inc. would submit a revised Decommissioning Funding Plan (DFP) to be consistent with remediation of the remainder of the CE Site. This DFP revision is enclosed, which addresses the entire CE Site, including the Site brook and associated debris piles.

This DFP replaces Revision 1 in its entirety since all tasks described are complete. Furthermore DFP Revision 2 includes ABB's NRC License No. SNM-1067 since it will be used in conjunction with License No. 06-00217-06 in order to complete decommissioning of the CE Windsor Site. This approach consolidates ABB's financial assurance for the CE Windsor Site into one set of documents and provides a comprehensive assessment of costs associated with achieving license termination for unrestricted use.

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Based on a discussion with Mr. James Schmidt during his on-site inspection (March 27, 2008), once the NRC concurs with this DFP, ABB will acquire the necessary and sufficient changes to its Standby Trust and associated financial instruments to meet the financial assurance requirements. ABB should be able to complete this action within 60 days of NRC concurrence of the DFP, at which time original financial documents will be transmitted to the NRC as required.

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
ABB requests that the cost estimate associated with DFP Revision 2 be withheld from public disclosure under 10 CFR 2.390. This is proprietary information that will affect competitive bids that ABB will solicit for decommissioning activities (remediation, transportation and waste disposal contractors). As such, a redacted version of DFP Revision 2 is also provided that can be made publicly available.
